CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Aymon called the special meeting of the McCall City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Aymon, Councilor Giles, Councilor Scott, Councilor Swanson and Councilor Witte answered roll call. A quorum was present.

City staff present was Gene Drabinski, City Manager; Traci Malvich, Human Resources Manager.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:00 p.m., Councilor Witte moved to go into Executive Session for: Hiring - Pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(1)(a): to consider hiring a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, wherein the respective qualities of individuals are to be evaluated in order to fill a particular vacancy or need. This paragraph does not apply to filling a vacancy in an elective office or deliberations about staffing needs in general; Councilor Giles seconded the motion. In a roll call vote Councilor Witte, Councilor Giles, Mayor Aymon, Councilor Scott, and Councilor Swanson, all voted aye and the motion carried.

Council discussed the hiring of Nate Coyle as the City Manager.

RETURN TO OPEN SESSION

At 6:30 p.m., Councilor Giles moved to return to Open Session. Councilor Witte seconded the motion. In a voice call vote, all voted aye and the motion carried.

Council directed staff to prepare the City Manager Contract for the August 13, 2015 City Council Meeting.

MEET AND GREET

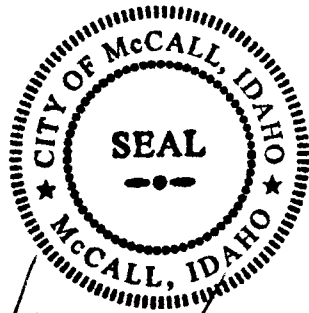
Various staff members and members of the public were present.
