



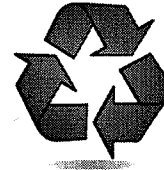
## Environmental Advisory Committee



- **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL-** EAC members present were Deb Fereday, Morgan Zedalis, and Sean Gould along with City of McCall's Recreation Supervisor Mark Pernell.
- **Public Comment** – No public comment
- **Noxious weeds** –EAC members discussed the upcoming spray day for noxious weeds tentatively scheduled for July 7<sup>th</sup> and is comprised of many government agencies. EAC members would like to do something similar but for community members and on a weekend. EAC members will check with high school for facility request/date, develop a series of run-up articles for the Star News, and acquire information noxious weed brochures for the event. Members will also try to coordinate to have Steve Anderson from Valley County to be present and perhaps other professions with knowledge of noxious weed controls. Event tentatively scheduled for June 25
- **Green Brochure** – There still needs to be a few more edits to the brochure before the final product and proposal is presented to City Council for its 3<sup>rd</sup> review which will most likely be at one of the May council meetings. Green certification stickers can be purchased for \$65 for 100 stickers to certify businesses recognized by the committee as using green business practices. Once brochure edits are complete and if council approves, City of McCall staff will proceed to print and distribute around the community.
- **Water Quality-** EAC members would still like to speak with Stephanie Jenkins (DEQ) to about the current criteria set for measuring lake quality of Payette Lake. After clarification from DEQ EAC members will then meet on to proceed for lake quality efforts for Payette Lake.

  - **Next meeting – May 17, 2016** – Agenda items for the next meeting are Noxious Weeds, Green Brochure, McCall Pristine, Air Quality, Water Quality, and Vote to change member charter.
