### COMMITTEE MEETING – Begins at 6 p.m.

- **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL-** EAC members present were Morgan Zedalis, Sean Gould, Steve Goodall, Leslie Dorsey and City of McCall's Parks and Recreation staff Dennis Coyle and Tara Woods.
- **Noxious Weeds-** EAC members discussed adding City of McCall's Noxious Weed Plan to the EAC website. Continued work on article for Star-News; includes impacts of noxious weeds on public and private lands, motivators to control spread, highlight top 3 in Valley County. Plans to publish article immediately after County finishes its 5 noxious weed ads. Discussed piggybacking with Children's Forest Day event at Payette State Park set for Saturday, July 9<sup>th</sup>. Plan to have booth with kid friendly activities about noxious weeds, literature, plant samples, and list of resources (biological, mechanical and environmentally friendly weed applications). Steve may have monies in county weed budget to help with educational brochures, posters, etc. for event. City of McCall's plotter for posters, if county was unable to print posters.
- **Green Brochure-** After confirming with Bessie Jo in City Clerk's office, it was decided to use [mccalleac@gmail.com](mailto:mccalleac@gmail.com) as email to be printed on brochure. Rocky Mountain Signs can print 100 decal stickers for \$66. EAC discussed to check with Big Payette Lake Water Quality Council on funding the decals. A final copy of the brochure, secured funding for decals, and final design would be approved for city council during the June 23 meeting. Agenda Bills due June 14.
- **Air Quality-** Steve Goodall reported on his discussions with City Council on May 12 were well received; with approval to move forward with item #7 (biomass plant) from the recommendations for the Clean Air Proposal. He met with Council's Superintendent Murray Dalglish about their plant and discussed possible locations for a plant in Valley County. It was agreed to continue researching biomass plants, as well as contact a number of Idaho engineering firms.
- **Water Quality-** EAC members would like to set a meeting with Stephanie Jenkins (DEQ) in early June to discuss (1) standards set by DEQ in monitoring water quality (2) criteria for those standards and (3) how the sample sights were chosen. After clarification from DEQ, EAC members will meet on how to proceed for lake quality efforts for Payette Lake.
- **McCall Pristine-** An update on the event, coordinated by Sean D'Amboise, was successful, food donated by Bonnie at the Pancake House, 2 parks staff members were there to help and many volunteers cleaned lots of trash from the lake.
- **Next Meeting** set for June 21 or possibly after the meeting with Stephanie Jenkins in early June.
