

MINUTES OF THE MCCALL GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE
SEPTEMBER 12, 2007

The McCall Golf Advisory Committee (GAC) was convened at 5:37 PM September 12, 2007 in the Golf Club House.

Attendees: Bob Giles, Chairman; Hank McCauley, Vc/Sec.; Roger Snodgrass; Allan Morrison, Head Pro; Eric McCormick, Superintendent.

STAFF REPORTS:

Allan Morrison reported that the Two Man Scramble tournament was successful. Fast play and good weather made for happy golfers. Also, next weeks Chapman Tournament is receiving more entrants than anticipated and the Cedar course may be used.

Eric McCormick reported:

1. The Benefit Tournament, held Sept 3, raised over \$13,000. The plan is to use \$12,500 of these funds along with \$29,500 in LOT funds, \$2000 from the McCall Ladies Golf Assn. and \$4000 from the McCall Mens Golf Assn. to buy an ASV Track Loader. The loader will be very useful for removing snow from the course in the winter and providing earth moving for golf course improvement projects.
2. Fairway aerification is in progress. Cedar has been done and other fairways will be completed later.
3. The staff is down to eight with the departure of summer workers.
4. Spraying for Knot Weed will be done this Fall and in the Spring.
5. Although rounds played is up this year, revenues will not reach budget expectations.

GAC BUSINESS:

1. It was noted that the Committee is still short one member. The City should advertise for this position in the newspaper as it does for other Committees and members should solicit interested individuals to apply.
2. The MLGA has suggested that #8 Birch ladies tee box be moved as it is currently too close to #8 Aspen line of flight. Eric said he would work with the women to reposition the teeing area.
3. The 5-YEAR PLAN presented at the August meeting by the architect Roger Snodgrass, was approved with one change. The item to establish senior (gray) teeing areas was moved forward from 2012 to 2008. This will allow the new tees to be incorporated in the re-rating of the entire course scheduled for 2008.

4. The MLGA has selected Susan Gephart as their new representative to the GAC. City Council approval is requested.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:09 PM.
