

Historic Preservation Commission
Minutes 3/16/04

Present: Judy Dinwiddie, Marlene Bailey, Pat Eames, Carol Coyle

Judy called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Carol reported that Mary Allen submitted a letter of resignation from the Commission. Mary indicated that she would contact Mark Schreiter to see if he was interested in serving. Robert Vosskuhler has submitted a letter of intent to serve on the Commission. A copy of his letter was given to Commission members to review.

Judy moved to recommend Robert Vosskuhler to the Council for appointment to the Historic Preservation Commission. Marlene seconded the motion. Motion passed. Carol will prepare an agenda bill for the City Council regarding the recommendation.

The minutes of 1/20/04 were distributed and read. Judy moved and Marlene seconded the motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed. The minutes of 2/24/04 were distributed and read. Judy moved and Pat seconded the motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

The CLG training in Island Park was discussed. It was suggested that more information regarding the agenda be obtained. Carol will contact Anne Swanson. Members discussed seeking out other trainings closer to McCall, or perhaps day long workshops. Members indicated they would be interested in the "how tos" of inventories and discussion about what other communities have done. It was suggested that the City of McCall seek CLG funding for future training opportunities.

Judy discussed her wish to pursue the development walking tour brochure, and is eager to get started. She will get a map with addresses on Lake Street. Pat suggested the brochure include some historical information on the properties that are listed. It was discussed that this could be a "trial" brochure, allowing for future editing. Carol said that the printing could be done at the City. Judy will come to the April 20th meeting with an outline for members' consideration.

Pat mentioned the new photos in the library. Mr. Goodman donated pictures of a restaurant that was in the open space near the Yacht Club. Pat mentioned she is compiling information on McCall's founding.

Members discussed a "field trip" to Idaho City in May or June. Discussion was held regarding the space upstairs in the Fire Warden's house that will be used for Historic Preservation materials. Judy will discuss this with the CIMH Board.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:45 pm.
