

McCall Historic Preservation Commission
Minutes 8/20/08

Present: Bob Fairbrother, Marlene Bailey

The minutes of the June 24th meeting were reviewed. Carol noted that Jill Meyer had submitted her letter of resignation from the Commission. Carol will notify the City Clerk, who will issue a news release for new member recruitment.

Marlene reported on her recent attendance to the McCall Planning and Zoning Commission meeting regarding the application for the Grand Payette. She testified at the meeting that she would like the Commission to consider the proximity of a historic property (Carl Brown house) next to the proposed project site. She recommended that there be a buffer between the commercial development and the historic home.

Carol discussed the local recognition program and indicated that she would present the concept to the McCall City Council for consideration on August 28th. It was pointed out that once properties were identified and accepted by Council, then a walking tour brochure could be developed.

The upcoming CLG grant application was discussed. Marlene emphasized the need to continue the work to list properties on the National Register of Historic Places. The 2009 CLG grant could be used for this purpose. Of the properties identified to date, Marlene suggested Lake Street Station as a possible nominee. Carol will contact the owner.

The next meeting will be September 16, 2008.
