

McCall Historic Preservation Commission

Meeting Minutes 11/10/09

Present: Brian Corcoran, Sandi Hammond, Carol Coyle

Brian called the meeting to order and welcomed Sandi as a new member. A quorum was not present, so the minutes of the previous meeting were deferred until the next meeting.

Historic Landmark program:

Carol gave a brief history of the program and its progress to date. It was discussed that the property owners should be re-contacted by letter and a follow-up conversation. It is important to emphasize that it is not binding. Sandi spoke with a local property owner who has a home on Lake Street and she thought that person may be interested. Additional locations were discussed: Alpine Playhouse, Congregational Church, Hotel McCall, Railroad Depot and Station Master's house. Toll Station was the site of a former creamery. Sandi will follow up with property owners to discuss the possibility of participating, including the Mill Restaurant and Lardo's.

Carol reported that Jennifer Theisen submitted a letter to Dr. Ken Reid of the Idaho State Historical Society questioning the designation of the Samson Trail property as potentially eligible for listing on the National Register. To date, no reply has been received by the City.

Carol distributed information on the National Alliance of Preservation Commissions meeting in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Both Sandi and Brian indicated interest in attending.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:28 pm.
