

McCall Historic Preservation Commission

Meeting Minutes 5/4/10

Present: Brian Corcoran, Sandi Hammond, Marlene Bailey, Carol Coyle

Brian called the meeting to order at 1:35 pm. A quorum was present. The minutes of the March 16 meeting were reviewed. Sandi moved to approve the minutes, Marlene seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Chairperson report: Brian reported that he presented the annual HPC report to the City Council. He summarized the report and Carol noted that it was well received by the Council. Brian also attended recent FY11 budget discussions with the Council and other citizen committee members.

Carol reported that she had met with Marcia Witte, a McCall Councilmember, regarding the 2011 centennial celebration and discussed various ideas for the celebration.

Walking tour brochure: Brian outlined a strategy for developing the tour brochure:

- 1) locate "before" photos of the buildings on the walking tour by using the resources at the Museum, Star News archives, the Nelle Tobias collection, and Mountain House resources
- 2) develop background information on each building using worked previously done by Marlene Bailey, information at the Library, and at the Museum. Use anecdotal information provided by Bob Fairbrother
- 3) Design and layout using Publisher and city computer. Carol can assist with the layout and printing.

Locations that were discussed as possible inclusions are: Legacy Park, Theodore Hoff house, Mountain Monkey Business, Hotel McCall, Depot and Station Master's house, Toll Station, Old McCall Jail, Lakeview Hotel/Peabody Hotel area, Lake Street Station, Lake Street Plaza, Congregational Church, Yacht Club, former Goodman Oil building (Krahn's). The brochure will also direct visitors to other sites such as the Museum.

**City Birthday Party:** This year's celebration will be on Monday, July 19. Members suggested the event be held at Legacy Park. Carol will arrange for a location and cake, punch, etc. It was suggested that next year's celebration be promoted as well.

The next meeting date will be planned for the first week of June. Carol will contact members about possible meeting dates.
