

McCall Historic Preservation Commission

Meeting Minutes 6/7/10

Present: Sandi Hammond, Brian Corcoran, Bob Fairbrother, Carol Coyle

Brian called the meeting to order at 1:41pm. A quorum was present. The minutes of the last meeting were reviewed. Sandi moved to approve the minutes; Bob seconded the motion and the motion passed.

**Heritage Barn conference report:**

Bob reported on the Heritage Barn conference he attended in Walla Walla, Washington. He said that he learned that historic barns are very costly to maintain, and a number of federal regulations have affected owners' ability to use the barns for various purposes. He mentioned that Frank Eld of Donnelly was there to present information on Donnelly and the Sackerman building that was relocated to Donnelly and reinstalled through donations and volunteer work. Bob reported that there were attendees from Washington, Colorado and other area, and that there is a heritage barn program in the state of Washington. Other information he shared included: Texas has the most barns at 51,000 and Idaho has 684; barns provide habitat for a variety of wildlife; and it is estimated that 90% of the barns will be gone soon, as they are deteriorating rapidly through crumbling foundations and roofs are failing. Bob said the conference was well worth it, but he was disappointed that it was so heavily focused on government regulations to maintain the barns and the expense of preserving them.

**Historic Walking Tour brochure:**


