

Historic Preservation Commission
Meeting minutes May 17, 2011

Brian called the meeting to order. No quorum was present.

The walking tour brochure was reviewed, and suggested comments were made. Ann will incorporate those comments and meet with Garrett Mapp to finalize the brochure.

Carol updated the members on the CLG grant and asked that they proceed with recommending John Bertram of Planmakers to be retained as the consultant for the CLG funded historic preservation plan. Brian and Ann agreed that he should be recommended to Council for the contract. Carol will submit the request to the City Council on May 26.

Brian discussed the upcoming Centennial article in the Star News. It will be in the May 23rd edition and will be about the railroad coming to McCall. Carol showed a picture from the McCall Library collection of the depot and train dated in 1914. Brian suggested that the June article be about the timber industry and its influence on McCall and the July article would promote the Centennial and the walking tour.
