

Historic Preservation Commission Meeting
June 21, 2011

Brian called the meeting to order and attendees introduced themselves.
The minutes of 5/17/11 were approved.

John Bertram, Planmakers, was present to discuss the Historic Preservation Plan for the City of McCall, which is funded by a Certified Local Government grant.

John described his background and discussed the grant project. It will include the identification of two historic properties that might be eligible for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places as well as the identification of two potential historic districts.

Members provided input into areas and specific buildings that might be included. Carol gave John various resource information that has been gathered from other research efforts.
John will plan to spend time in McCall today to visit various locations.

Brian discussed the Centennial series articles and indicated that the June article will be about the influence of the timber industry and the contribution of the Brown family and that the July article will focus on the historic walking tour.

There will be no meeting in July as that will be the Centennial celebration.
