Meeting 10/28/10

The meeting was called to order at 2:08 pm. A quorum was present.

Sgt. Rittenger, McCall Police Department, presented "Code Enforcement 101". He emphasized that the most important aspect of effective code enforcement is the people doing the work. The MPD strives for voluntary compliance in code enforcement efforts. They try not to cite a person unless the non-compliant behavior will not change.

There are two full time code enforcement positions, with one of the positions as a job share position. Sgt. Rittenger reviewed definitions in the city code related to nuisances, signs, and refuse. He gave examples of what constitutes a violation and what does not.

Members discussed various existing code violations and Shorty distributed a list of areas of concern. There was a question and answer period after the presentation.

Treasurer's report: the report was not available.

The minutes were distributed and were approved.

Committee updates: Cathy said that the invitation list needs to be updated and it will be available at a future meeting.

Cathy discussed potential funding for the Million Lights project. She indicated that the MIC may be able to fund additional lights. Shorty indicated that to his knowledge, the lights had been purchased and no additional funding was needed at this time.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 pm.
