a.) Boat dock launch/Beach Concessionaire use agreement

Ray Dupree and Shawn Treasure, local members of our community can tonight to inform the committee that they would like to see and help with an Outrigger Canoe recreation program. It would be run in the summer, participants would learn how to use an outrigger canoe, and participate in rowing around the lake. This activity would be new to McCall and the only Outrigger Canoe Program in Idaho. It is something different, adds variety and could potential be a large program for the community. The difficult parts are finding a place to store the equipment and budgeting for the program. I will work with Shawn Treasure who

has years of experience with Outriggers to see if this could be a potential program to run this summer.
