PARKS

a.) Park Walk Through

Veterans Park:

- need to add 1-2 benches plus a trash container
(1 bench behind tree on north side where 1 bench now sits plus add a bench on the southside but NOT in front of the monument or plaques)
- Recommend planting red/white/blue poppies to MIC

Davis Beach:

- Will eventually need to rebuild walkway and make ADA compliant
- need to survey and fence the City's beach area
- review City's right-of-way along western edge of Pearl Street
- survey Diamond and Pearl streets when Davis/Lick Creek intersection is surveyed

Fairway:

- current plans are to add water supply and drinking fountain
- future plans are to add permanent restrooms
- possibility of obtaining open wetlands to the west of the ball fields for future parking lot
- investigate (price) the possibility of and the need for lights

North of Mile High Marina:

- remove old fish pen docks
- remove broken docks
- clean up Inland Marine's area
- put all safeguards in place to block Inland Marine's future lease of this area.
- research possibility of placing jet ski concessionaires here

Brown's Park:

- add better signage at front of entrance
- add "No Dogs" signage
- establish property line with condos and erect short fence
- repair or replace restrooms
- extend playground to grass area behind restrooms
- add benches along shoreline -add BBQs, tables & trash receptacles to the grassy north area
- add bicycle rack
- increase park rental fees for weddings etc
- add sand to wet area by park's entrance
- add Tulips

Art Roberts:

- increase beach area by cutting into the bank of the hill
- extend boardwalk from Faraday property to Krahn property
- remove/replace unsafe electric panel
- complete all electric/plumbing inspections etc in preparation for spring installation of new restrooms

Rotary:

- add bicycle rack on north side of restrooms
- eventually replace/repair floors and walls of restrooms
- replace playground equipment
- add BBQ plus table(s) to west grassy area behind restrooms
- add BBQ between 3 picnic tables in center of the park area
- update "No Dogs" signage

To all parks: further investigate the process of adding an aluminum can recycling program

discuss a site for a future dog park (unleashed) or at least a park where leashed dogs are welcome

At the Tuesday, October 2nd meeting, discuss advisability of offering a 3 year lease to any interested concessionaires
