**OLD BUSINESS**

1. The Tree committee invited contractors TC Williams from ECO Tech, Tall Timbers, De Ole Priddy, Steve Mello, Robert Tree Service, Teufel, High Mountain Nursery, Idaho Power, Fire Chief, Cathedral Pines project manager, Alpine Village project manager, and Fairway Condos project manager to make open comments to review the updated Tree Ordinance.
  - Comments was made by Curt Van Patten on section 8.17.8 section 5 to minimize the gallon species to comply to Idaho Power \$50.00 voucher on the right of way.
  - Also section 8.17.7 section C. to change the Utilities: Street trees shall not be planted within 25 ~~10~~ lateral feet of any overhead utility wire unless they were Class I trees.
  - He would like to see the change to add Class 1 tree definition in Section 8.17.4 and that they would be identified in our desirable tree list.
  - TC Williams from ECO Tech supported the new Tree Ordinance. He asked what the enforcement process would be for contractors that do not follow the code would be. John will contact Bill Nichols about whether the proposed ordinance speaks to this issue.
