



## McCall Fire Protection District's

### "Bring it – Don't Burn it (BIDBI)" Statistics

From 2005 thru 2011, the fire district issued -on average- 285 burn permits a year.

Since 2012, the average number of burn permits issued in McCall has dropped from 285 to an average of 85 a year, equal to a 70% reduction in open burning in and around the City of McCall.

- 2019 – 154 dumpsters
- 2020 – 154 dumpsters
- 2021 – 160 dumpsters

In the last three years, we have dumped 468 containers of woody debris from the McCall fire station (11,700 cubic yards, or 975 dump truck loads).

Over the past three years, a 70% reduction in burn permits equates to 328 open burning permits that were not issued, but instead, woody debris was disposed of through the BIDBI program.
