Artwork to be installed on Lardo Bridge September 10

McCall, Idaho—September 3, 2019

Blacksmith Susan Madacsi will install her artwork titled “Seasons” on Lardo Bridge beginning Tuesday, September 10. The public is invited to attend a brief dedication of the artwork by McCall Mayor Aymon and board members from the Idaho Transportation Department at 3:00 pm on Wednesday, September 11, 2019.

The artwork, chosen through community input workshops and surveys, will include four individual sculptures placed at the ends of the bridge spanning the outlet of Payette Lake. Each sculpture represents a season of the year in forged local botanical forms and thick kiln formed glass. Forged plant forms will also accent railings to carry the aesthetic theme throughout the span of the bridge. The budget for the public art project is \$50,000 and is funded by the City of McCall and a grant from National Endowment for the Arts.

The North Fork Payette River Bridge (Lardo Bridge), built in 1931, was replaced in 2015 by the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD). City of McCall leaders worked with ITD in advance of construction to identify priorities for the new bridge which included pedestrian and bicycle facilities, a viewing platform over the lake, and pedestals for public art to be placed.
