

Hydrant Fill Station Application and Inspection Form

The City of McCall, Public Works Department, requires that all individuals or businesses wishing to obtain water from any city service with the objective of filling a water truck or tank must comply with the following requirements.

1. Must pay a fee of \$100.00 for each water truck or tank obtaining water per year.
2. MUST DISPLAY the inspection sticker on the left side of the tank to be visible from a distance.
3. Water flow from the city service will only be controlled through the control valve, NOT through the operating valve of the hydrant.
4. Will have a minimum of a 6" airgap on the tanks fill opening.
5. NO hose will be inserted into the tank during filling.
6. If a valve and hose is not attached, it will be the driver's responsibility to supply.
7. ALL potable water trucks or tanks that fill through a backflow device, MUST first provide a copy of their current Idaho Health Department certification form or tag before obtaining water.
8. If the truck or tank undergoes any major alterations during original inspection year, that truck or tank will have to be re-inspected before additional water is obtained.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS COULD RESULT IN AN INABILITY TO RECEIVE WATER WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.
